### CHRISTINA SERVICES

#### **Christina Services**

October 17- The Masks We Wear- Happy Halloween! Join as as we explore the many masks we wear every day of the year, and the tricks and treats that come along with them.

November 21- For Praying Out Loud- As Unitarian Universalists, we sometimes struggle with traditional prayer language. We don't agree on many theological claims, so how are we to understand prayer? As Thanksgiving approaches, let's consider prayer from a UU perspective.

December 19- Darkness and Light- The time of darkness is almost at its longest, and the light will soon return. In this season of cold and dark, what do we want to leave behind in the old year, and bring with us into the light of the new? A neo-pagan ritual of light will accompany some traditional and non-traditional holiday songs and imagery.

January 16- The Meaning of Grace- The Christian tradition emphasizes grace as God's gift to humanity, grace as a fresh start. "For the grace of God, which can save every person, has now been shown for all people, and it teaches us to have no more to do with godlessness or the desires of this world but to live, here and now, responsible, honorable, and God-fearing lives" (Titus 2:11-12). What does grace mean to Unitarian Universalists, and how can we embrace it this New Year?

February 20- Standing on the Side of Love and Justice- In a month dedicated to love, and dedicated to the memory of the continuing struggle for civil rights for African Americans, we dedicate this service to standing on the side of love in a world that seems bent on violence and destruction.

March 20- The Sermon on the Amount- Money makes the world go 'round, and the church community is no exception. What does stewardship mean? How can we all give generously to support the vision and mission of this congregation so it can continue to be a presence for love and justice in Fond du Lac?

April 17- Creationism and Earth Day- Famous 19th century Unitarian minister William Ellery Channing once said that if we are not allowed the latitude to read the Bible using human reason, we should "abandon the book to its enemies." Is that what we have done? Abandoned it? Let's reclaim some of the Creation stories of the Hebrew Bible and see how they might help us speak to our concerns about ecology and justice this Earth Day. Bring a Bible! It's going to be fun!
